CATEGORIES

NIAAA membership is for a one-year period from the date that dues are received. States with dual membership shall establish the month in which their membership year begins. That month becomes the annual membership renewal month for that state.

REGULAR MEMBERSHIP (\$60) is available to anyone employed by a school, school district or state association who has among his/her responsibilities the administration of interscholastic athletics. For benefits, see left panel.

ASSOCIATE MEMBERSHIP (\$60) is open to anyone who is involved in some phase of school or athletic administration at the collegiate level or who is an instructor in athletic administration. Associate members receive all benefits and services afforded a regular member, except holding office.

STUDENT MEMBERSHIP (\$15) is open to anyone enrolled in college classes associated with education or athletic administration, management or marketing. Student members receive all benefits afforded a regular member, except insurance benefits and holding office.

****RETIRED MEMBERSHIP (\$30)** is open to any person who has retired from a school, school district or state association who had among his/her responsibilities the administration of interscholastic athletics. Retired members receive all benefits (except liability insurance) and services afforded a regular member, including the opportunity to serve on committees but may not hold leadership positions.

****NOTE:** If you are retired, but are still active as an athletic administrator in a voluntary or compensated capacity, then you should join under the "Regular Retired" membership category as all insurance coverage would apply.

REGULAR LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP (1 payment - \$600; 2 consecutive payments - \$325 each) is an option available to anyone who qualifies for regular membership. Lifetime members receive all benefits and services afforded a regular member. There are two payment plans available: one-time payment of \$600 or two consecutive year payments of \$325 each. (Individuals choosing the two consecutive payment plan would not be considered a lifetime member until both payments are received. There would be no refund of the first payment.)

RETIRED LIFETIME MEMBERSHIP (\$300) is an option available to anyone who qualifies for retired membership. Retired members receive all benefits (except liability insurance) and services afforded a regular member, including the opportunity to serve on committees but may not hold leadership positions. Retired lifetime membership is a one-time payment of \$300.
